

Dr. Joel Beeke is president and professor of Systematic Theology and Homiletics at Puritan Reformed Theological Seminary, a pastor of the Heritage Reformed Congregation in Grand Rapids, Michigan, and Board Chairman of Reformation Heritage Books. He has written and co-authored over one hundred twenty books, edited another one hundred books, and contributed 2,500 articles to Reformed books, journals, periodicals, and encyclopedias. He and his wife, Mary, have been blessed with three children and 9 grandchildren.

DR. JOSEPH A. PIPA, JR. is President Emeritus and Professor of Systematic & Applied Theology at Greenville Presbyterian Theological Seminary in South Carolina. He has pastored churches in Mississippi, Texas, California, and South Carolina. He is the author of several books on a variety of biblical and theological topics.
